Deadline: Rolling (Concept Papers). Grants of up to \$400,000 over three years will  
be awarded to projects that confront gaps in the civic knowledge of undergraduates  
and prepares them for the intellectual demands of democratic participation.

***Toshiba America Foundation Accepting Applications for Science, Math  
Projects,*** Deadline: Rolling. Grants will be awarded to teachers in grades 6-12 who  
are passionate about making science and math more engaging for their students.

***Westinghouse Charitable Giving Program Accepting Proposals***, Deadline: Open. Grants are awarded to programs in one or more of the organization's priority funding areas, including education (with a focus on STEM disciplines), environmental sustainability, and community safety and vitality.
